WHY COZUMEL?

PERFECT WEATHER & ENDLESS DIVE SITES

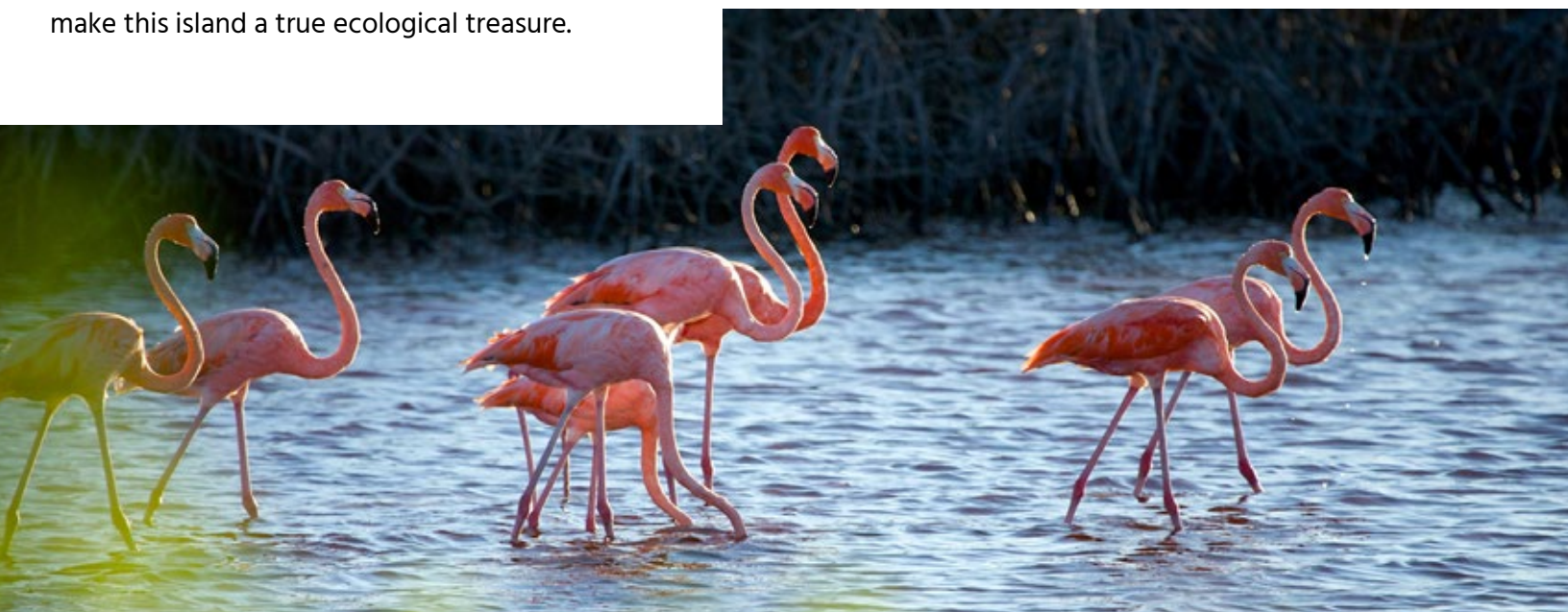




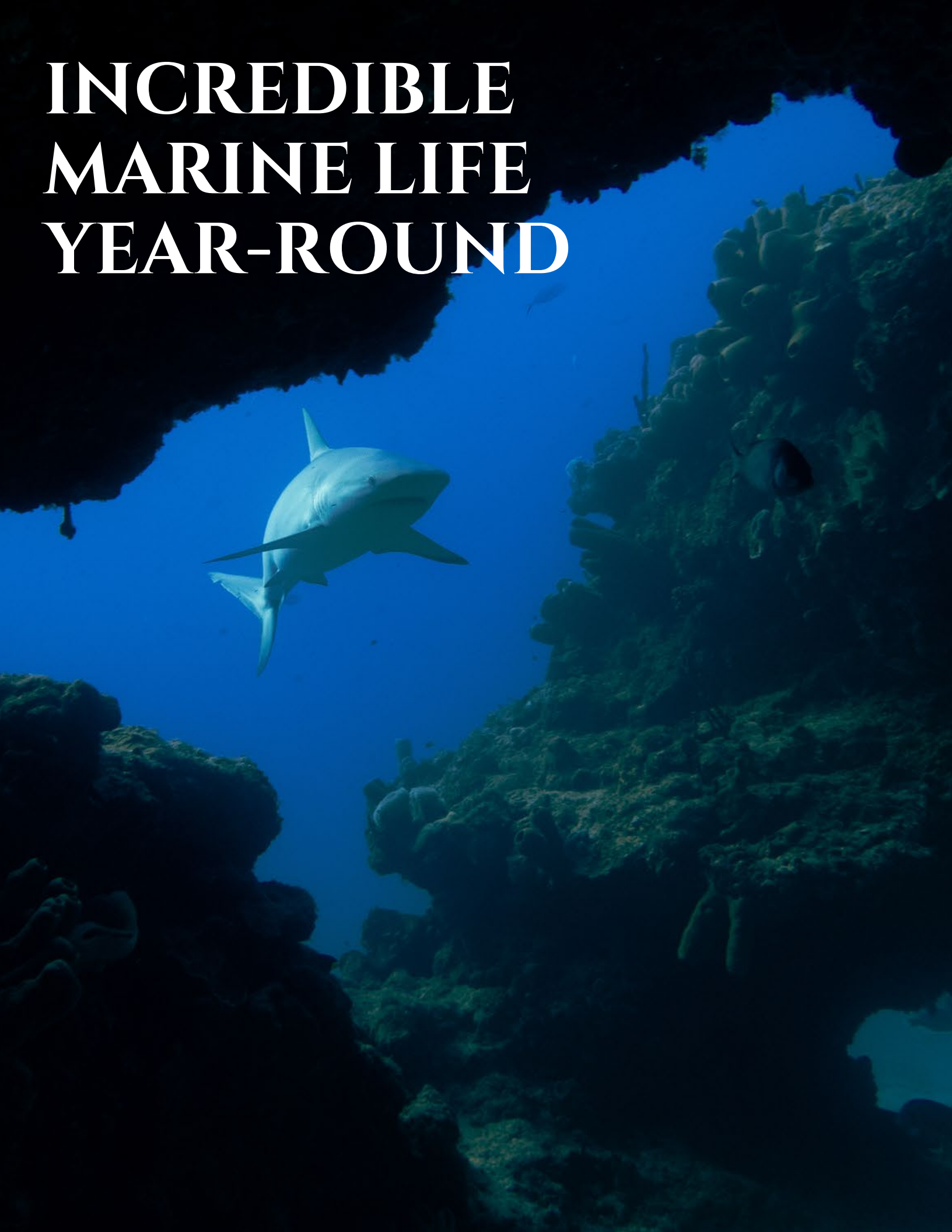

Keep an eye out for the adorable Cozumel raccoon, the elusive pygmy skunk, or colorful parrots soaring through the treetops, or even an occasional crocodile sunbathing in the mangroves. Bird enthusiasts can spot colorful parrots, and migratory species like the American flamingo.

All of this wildlife and more can be found in Parque Punta Sur, one of the most exciting guided stops you'll visit during your stay. It is an ecological reserve that showcases the island's rich Mayan heritage, with over 36 archaeological sites, ceremonial centers, and ancient pilgrimage routes.

You'll be exploring Cozumel underwater and on land. There's a thriving world of creatures that make this island a true ecological treasure.

Summer, on the other hand, turns Cozumel into a sea turtle haven, with thousands of Green and Loggerhead turtles nesting on the island's shores and soaring through the currents. Lose yourself in the enchantment of Columbia Reef, feel the thrill of exploring the legendary Devil's Throat at Punta Sur. And let's not forget the world-famous Palancar Reef, with its towering coral formations, or Paradise Reef, where marine life practically poses for your GoPro.

November - April

- Slow currents, windy, cold
- Water temp: 27C/80F
- Eagle ray & bullshark season



SPRING



April - June

- Stronger currents, less wind, sunny, flat sea
- Water temp: 28-29C/82-84F
- Octopi, lobsters, crabs

FALL



September - December

- Stronger currents, windy, rainy
- Water temp: dropping 30-28C/86-82F
- Juvenile sharks, drumfish, flounders, nudibranch

- Visitor's Permit (FMM)

- Prescription

PACKING ESSENTIALS

WEATHER-APPROPRIATE CLOTHING:

- Lightweight Clothing
- Swimwear and Cover-Up
- Sun Protection: Bring hats, sunglasses, any kind of sunscreen is forbidden in the Marine Parks- if you wish to bring long sleeve rash guards for further protection
- MAYBE a light rain jacket for the rainy-season
- Reusable Water Bottle
- Water Shoes and Flip-Flops
- Bug Spray and After-Bite Cream: Mosquitoes can be present year-round, so bring repellent and treatment if you're sensitive to bites, or of course, you can purchase it here.



VISAS:

To enter Mexico as a tourist from the United States or Canada, you need:

- A valid passport with at least six months remaining beyond your departure date
- A completed Forma Migratoria Múltiple (FMM), Mexico's official tourist card
- Tourist Visa (on arrival)

US and Canadian citizens do not require a traditional visa to enter Mexico for tourism, business, or short stays up to 180 days.

Once you arrive in Cancun, we can arrange for a private car or taxi to pick you up.
Or you may wish to take the ADO bus to Playa Del Carmen Ferry Terminal.

The ferry takes approximately 40 minutes to arrive in Cozumel.



TRAVEL TIPS FOR MEXICO FROM THE USA AND CANADA



FOOD AND WATER

Bottled Water: Tap water in Mexico is generally not safe for drinking. Stick to refillable water bottles. Purified water is widely available. Many places offer purified water stations.

Cuisine for Vegan and Vegetarian Travelers: Vegan and vegetarian options have become more available. All restaurants on our list have these options included.

Special Dietary Needs: If you have food allergies or dietary restrictions, mention them explicitly to the staff

IMMIGRATION

Customs and Duty-Free: Declare items over the duty-free allowance when entering. Mexico has strict regulations on bringing certain foods, plants, and large amounts of currency.



GENERAL SECURITY

- Cozumel has been one of the safest places in Mexico
- Law enforcement is easily found
- Personal Belongings: Use secure bags or backpacks. Don't carry large amounts of cash, and leave valuables like passports in your B&B safe when possible.
- Scams Awareness: Be cautious of overly friendly strangers offering assistance or deals. Stick to reputable tour companies and establishments.
- Emergency Numbers: The emergency number in Mexico is 911. Familiarize yourself with this and ensure you know the name and location of your accommodation.



HYGIENE AND HEALTH

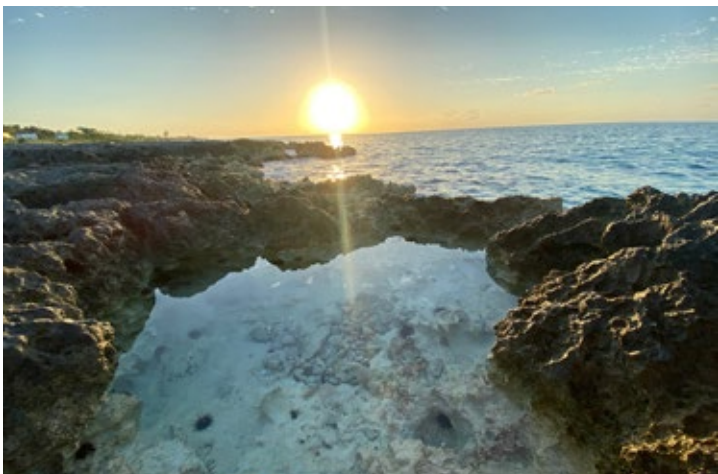
- Soaps, Shampoo, and Toiletries: Basic toiletries are widely available, but bring any special products. Eco-friendly accommodations may offer biodegradable soaps, as Cozumel in particular encourages reef conservation efforts.
- Toilet Paper Disposal: All places in Mexico, especially older plumbing systems, request that you do not flush toilet paper. Follow local signage, as disposals are usually provided next to toilets.

Public Restrooms: Often found in cafes, restaurants, or malls. Some require a small fee or purchase to use, so it's helpful to carry small change.



ADDITIONAL TIPS

- **Currency and Payment:** Mexican pesos are the official currency, though USD is commonly accepted in most spots. It's generally better to use pesos for a fair exchange rate.
- **ATM Use:** Use ATMs inside banks when possible for added security. Avoid using standalone ATMs late at night or in secluded areas.
- **Weather Preparedness:** Mexico's climate varies widely by region and season. Be prepared for both sun protection and occasional rain, depending on the season.
- **Time Zone:** Check local time zones, as Mexico spans several. Cozumel, for instance, is on Eastern Standard Time from Nov-June, Central Standard from June-Nov.
- **Eco-friendly Sun Cover** (hat/ UV protected rash guards/ sunglasses).



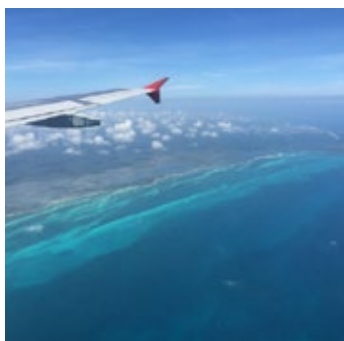


Afternoon & Evening:

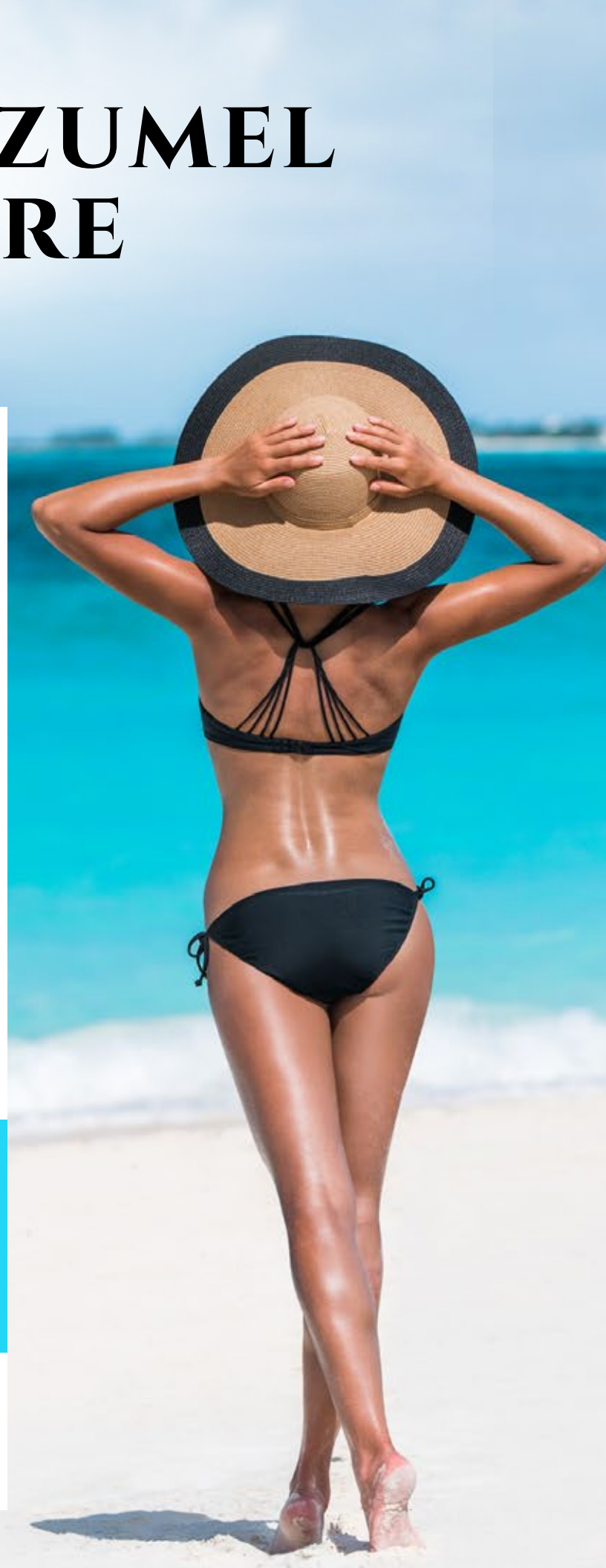
